

APRIL 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Fabric: White, Light/Medium Blue,
Dark Blue, Light green

Cutting:

Light Blue – cut one 7" square, cut in half on the diagonal
Light Green – cut one 7" square, cut in half on the diagonal
Dark Blue – cut four 3-1/2" squares
White – cut four 3-1/2" squares

Sewing:

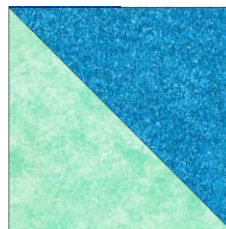
Sew one dark blue square to one white square,
make four sets.

Sew two sets of four patches using the white
and dark blue sets of squares.

These should measure 6-1/2" square
when finished.



Sew one light green triangle to one light blue triangle
on the long diagonal side, make two sets.
Trim these new squares to 6-1/2"



Assemble the block using these 4 units as shown above. Press to the half square triangles.

Finished raw block should measure 12-1/2" X 12-1/2"

Don't forget to make your own block to keep for your sampler quilt! 😊

Make this block to bring to the meeting in the colors shown above. Make another block in your own fabrics to keep at home for your sampler quilt.
