AUGUST 2015 BOM

JEWELLED STRIPS BLOCK

10" FINISHED BLOCK

FABRICS: JEWEL TONE – BLUE, PINK, PURPLE
(USE 4 FABRICS TOTAL)

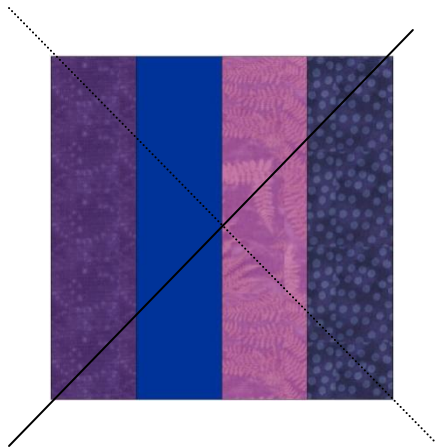
Cutting:

Cut two strips from each fabric – 2-1/2" X 8-1/5" (8 strips total)

Sewing:

Line up one strip of each color and sew together on the long side.
Make two. Finished it should measure 8.5" X 8.5".

Make two cuts across each square from opposite corners.



You should now have 8 triangles total. Arrange 4 with their points facing in and sew together to make a new square. Arrange the remaining 4 around the outside edge of this new square to make the final, larger square.

Trim this final block to 10-1/2" square.

**When you are sewing the triangles back together after cutting them – arrange them however you want to! Just make sure your finished square is trimmed to 10.5" when you're all done.
