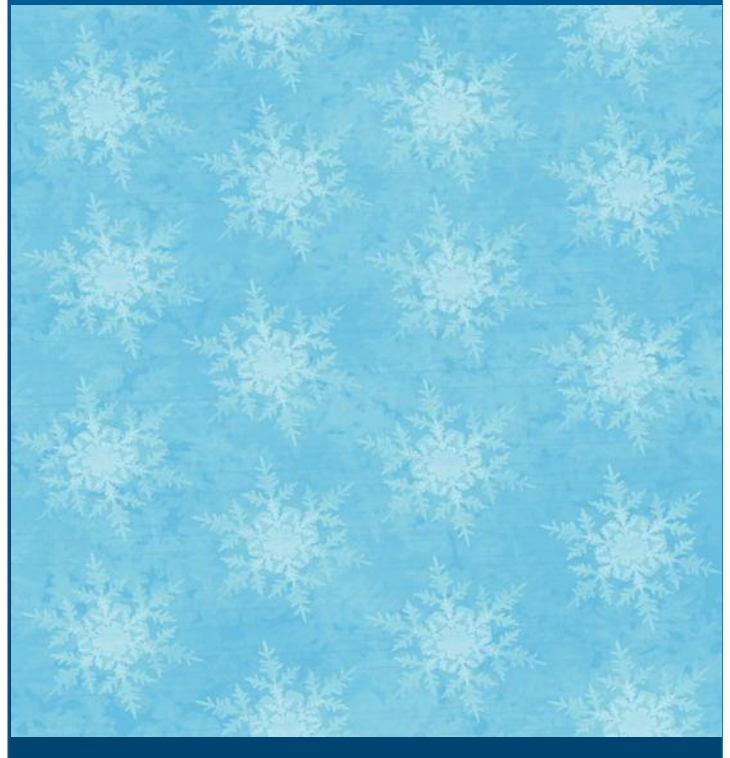
October 14, 1015 "Where did You Get That Idea?" with Lee Anna Paylor will be our lecture.

2015 RAFFLE QUILT

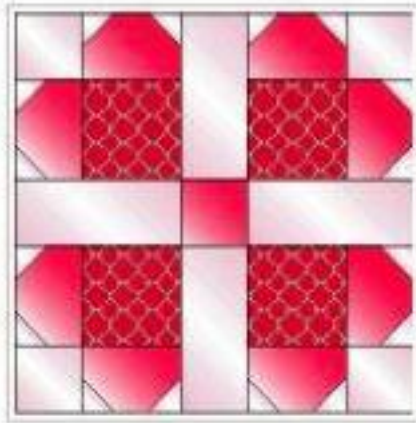
Construction has progressed beautifully on the 2015 Raffle Quilt.

FEBRUARY 2015 BOM

PIECED HEARTS BLOCK

12" FINISHED BLOCK

FABRICS: **Scrappy White and Reds**

Pattern from McCall's Quilting

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1

... 16 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (Piece 1A)

... 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (Piece 1B)

... 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" (Piece 1C)

Fabric 2, Red Print

... 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" (Piece 2D)

Fabric 3, Red

... 1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (Piece 3B)

... 8 rectangles 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" (Piece 3E)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Piece 1A squares. Align squares with Piece 3E rectangle, top corners, right sides together (**Diagram I**). Sew on previously drawn line. Cut away excess fabric leaving 1/4" seam allowance. Make 8 total pieced rectangles.

Step 2. Referring to **Diagram II**, sew together 2 pieced rectangles, Piece 1B and Piece 2D to form corner unit. Make 4 total pieced squares.

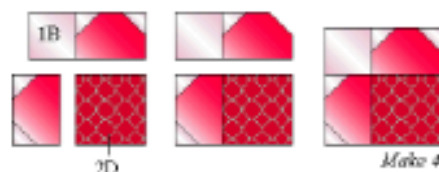

Step 3. Referring to **Diagram III** for unit/piece placement guide, sew 3 rows using 4 corner units, 4 background strips, and red 2 1/2" square. Sew rows together to make Pieced Hearts Block.

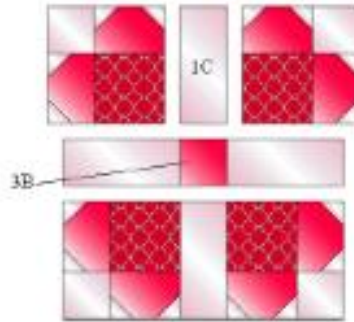
