

FEBRUARY 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

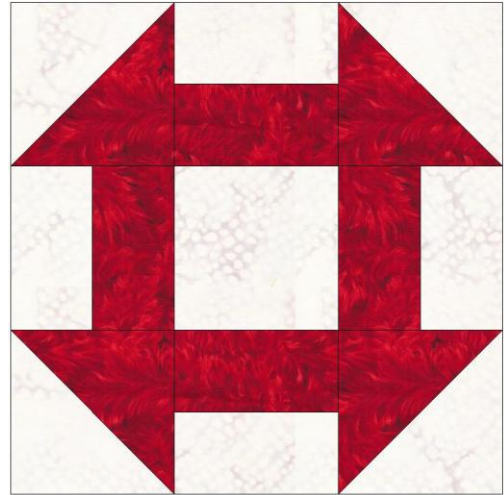
Fabric: Red Fabric and White Fabric

Cutting:

Cut 2 squares each at 4-7/8" from the red and white fabric. Cut those squares in half on the diagonal to make FOUR triangles.

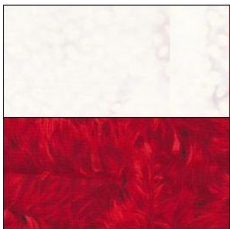
Cut one 4-1/2" square of the white fabric.

Cut four rectangle pieces from each fabric 4-1/2" X 2-1/2"



Sewing:

Match each white triangle to a red triangle and sew along the longest edge to make FOUR half-square triangles.



Sew FOUR pairs of red and white bars together using the rectangles. Sew along the longest edge.

Sew one set of bars in between two triangle sets. Make Two.



Sew the other sets of bars to opposite sides of the center white square. Make One.

You should now have three rows of the block assembled. Sew these rows in order as shown above.

Press all fabrics to the red side. Don't forget to make a block in your own fabrics to save for your sampler quilt! ☺ When you have finished these blocks they should measure 12-1/2" X 12-1/2".
