End of year budget was presented, still in good shape. Will make available at the meeting.

Past year's budgets - receipts and paperwork were in the folder since 2004. IRS requires only paperwork for the last three years for audit purposes for a 501.3(c) organization. Board agreed to shred/dispose of old documents in Treasurer's possession paperwork from 2004-2011.

Notice of PNC Bank Fees - Effective in April, there are maintenance fees on checking accounts with a balance under \$500. As long as there is a \$500 balance in our account there will be no fees. We do not meet any of the criteria for paying fees.

Nominating Committee - Board members must appoint a nominating committee for the next elections.

**Minutes** - Motion to accept the minutes was made by Kate McMinn and seconded by Linda Gallagher.

**Membership** - We had five visitors: Alice Kyle, Joann Roberts, Marti Clevenger, Tammy Hornick, and Chevelle Dorshaw. No new members.

**Community Service** - Making quilts for CASA, Project Linus is willing to help. CASA serves

the three counties: Calvert, St. Mary's and Charles. Right now there are about 47 kids in the system, but the number of kids fluctuates. The goal is to make a quilt for each of them, ready for the November 2017 meeting. Project Linus is willing to help as well. Other Quilt Guilds were called to challenge them, but no word back yet.

**FEBRUARY 2017 BLOCK OF THE MONTH**

**Ohio Star (courtesy of McCalls Quilting.com)**

**Fabrics:** black and two bright colors

**Cutting Instructions:**

**Black**

... 4 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

... 2 squares 5 1/4" x 5 1/4", cut twice diagonally to make quarter-square triangles - yield: 8

**Bright Color #1**

... 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

**Bright Color #2**

... 2 squares 5 1/4" x 5 1/4", cut twice diagonally to make quarter-square triangles - yield: 8

**Assembly Instructions:**

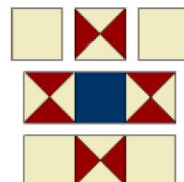
1. Referring to Diagram I, make 4 pieced-square sub units.
2. Referring to Assembly Diagram, sew pieced-squares to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" cream and blue print squares. Sew rows together to make Ohio Star Block.



Size: 12" Finished  
(12-1/2" rough edges)
