
JULY 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Fabric: Black, Pink, Light Green (prints or solids or mixture)

Cutting:

Cut one 7-1/4" square of Pink and one of Green Cut Two 7-1/4" squares of Black

Cut each square in half twice diagonally. This will yield four green triangles, 4 pink triangles, and 8 black triangles.





Sewing:

Pair each colored triangle with a black triangle. Sew together on the shorter sides. Sew two of each on the left seam and two of each on the right seam. This way when they are opened up and pressed you will have opposites.

Match your center seams and sew each color coordinating set together to make a small square.

Sew your four small squares together as shown above to make a finished block. Your rough edged block should measure 12.5" X 12.5"
