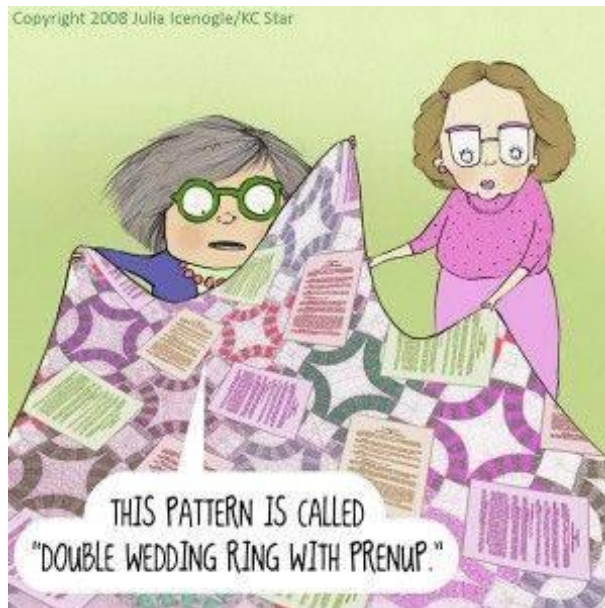

3 May 2016**

Board Meeting Commenced at 7:08 pm

Discussions:

Pat Blackford wished to apologize to the Board and to the Guild. She had a conversation with Hilke Hoefler. Pat's intent was to get more people involved in Annmarie Garden and other events. She did not mean to hurt feelings or insult Hilke in any way. Pat was stunned by the amount of emails she received. Again, she was only trying get more Guild members involved. Hilke is willing to still work on wrangling Annmarie Garden and the Calvert County Fair.

Taxes - Allison finished and filed the taxes on time.

Restitution - Allison had the paperwork to submit for filing for a civil suit for restitution. The paperwork will be submitted in St. Marys County, since that is where the person currently resides, despite prior judgment being in Calvert County.



Election of Officers - According to by-laws (will double-check), we still are required to hold an election. No one has come forward yet. If anyone wishes to run against any office holders, they are welcome to have their names added. June meeting will have the elections. Also, this will be the last year for each holding the offices, as there is a two-year limit for office holders. Ballots need to be made. Allison - email with last request. Pat will read the by-laws. Andrea will print up ballots.

A decision was made to donate to the local firehouse/rescue squad in memory of Susan White's husband, as prescribed in the by-laws. Research will be done as to what county and firehouse/rescue squad is in the county or area in which Susan White lives.

Annmarie Garden - Hilke and her posse are still very much in charge of wrangling it. She sent a list of items that did not sell well from the Calvert County Fair. We are awaiting what sold/didn't sell at Artfest.

Did not sell well: walker bags, Christmas ornaments

Sold Well: crayon holder / kids totes; Fish trivets/placemats; zippered wallet.

With Hilke wrangling AMG/Artsfest, we need someone willing to take on Community Service.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.

## Calvert County Quilt Guild Meeting

11 May 2016

Meeting commenced at 7:00pm  
No guest speaker tonight; Election night.

Welcome to May = named after Greek goddess Maia; named for mayoris.

The President apologized to everyone and especially Hilke Hoefer. First, about last meeting, Pat did not speak with Hilke prior to making any announcements at the meeting. Second, she apologized to Hilke (who had not yet arrived). Pat meant no offense to Hilke or to the Guild. Her intent was trying to get everyone involved. After speaking with Hilke privately, Hilke will keep wrangling folks to support Artsfest at Annmarie Garden. She will, however, give up the Community Service position.

Minutes - No changes to the minutes from last month. Betty Tilley made a motion to accept; Kate McMinn seconded.



Treasury - Income of \$142; Paid out \$918.52 (P.O. Box, Tickets for raffle quilt, speaker). Filed a motion in Small Claims Court of St. Mary's County for restitution. Court fees to date have been \$174, of the \$500 budgeted amount.

Membership - We had one guest, Ms. Amy Thompson.

Executive Board - \$50 donation was made to Prince Frederick Rescue Squad in honor of Susan White's husband.

Kate McMinn began distributing raffle tickets to Quilt Guild members. SELL, SELL SELL!!

Audit - two volunteers needed to audit the books of the guild. Audit must be completed by the July Board Meeting. Jayne Roxey and Kate McMinn volunteered.

Elections - two volunteers needed for elections - volunteers were Terri Franklin and Anita Konzak. The current board members are willing to stay in place another year, however, next year newly elected officials will be needed. Tonight, we have ballots and we must vote tonight.

Annmarie Garden - dates are 17 & 18 September - Hilke will send the shift schedule to Pat so that it can be posted and people can sign up.

Jayne Roxey made a motion to adjourn; Betty Tilley seconded. The meeting adjourned at 8:17pm.

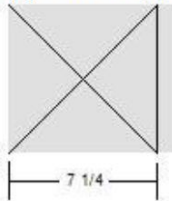
**JUNE 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH**

**Fabric:** Black & Light Grey, White & Dark Grey

**Cutting:**

Black & White Fabrics:

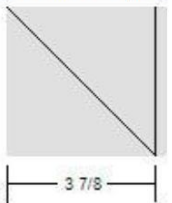
- Cut one 7-1/4" square of each fabric
- Cut that square in half twice by cutting from the opposite corners to make four triangles



- You should have FOUR triangles of each color

Light Grey & Dark Grey Fabrics

- Cut FOUR 3-7/8" squares of each fabric
- Cut that square in half once diagonally to make 2 triangles



- You should have 8 triangles of each color



**Sewing:**

Sew two dark grey triangles to each white triangle to make a rectangle.  
Make 4 sets.



Sew two light grey triangles to each black triangle to make a rectangle. Make 4 sets.

Sew two rectangles of each color together with the triangles pointing the same way.

Assemble the 4 sets as shown above and sew together to finish the block.  
Your final block should measure 12-1/2" X 12-1/2".



**Don't forget to make your own block in your own colors to keep for your sampler quilt! ☺**
