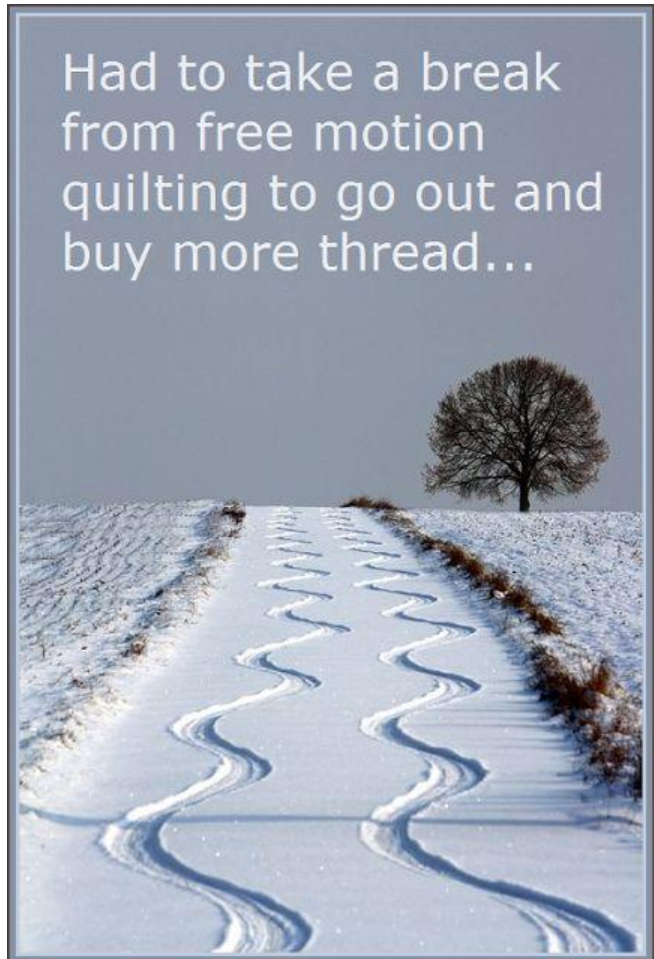

Later that month, Saturday, April 23, we will have Nancy lead us in a workshop on how to make her "Glimmer Glass Quilt." Nancy likes to use bright colors found in her extensive stash of Kaffe Fassett and Philip Jacobs fabrics. However, this pattern would also look great using a more limited color palette, such as red, white and black, or scrappy. The key is many different fabric squares. Repetition makes a less interesting quilt. This quilt uses primarily half square triangles. So anyone from beginner to experienced will be successful with this pattern.

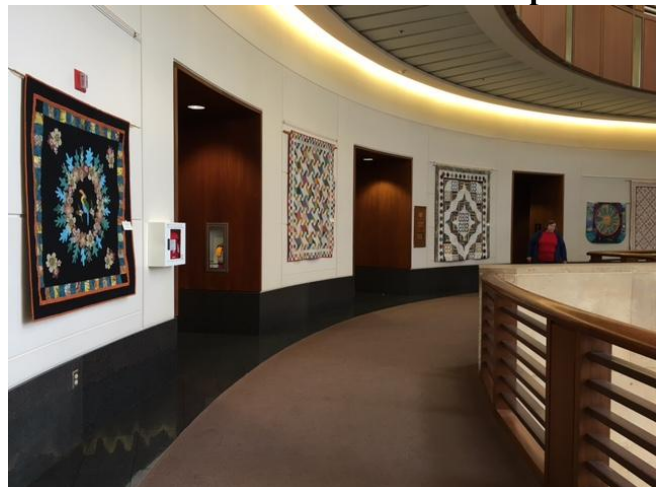

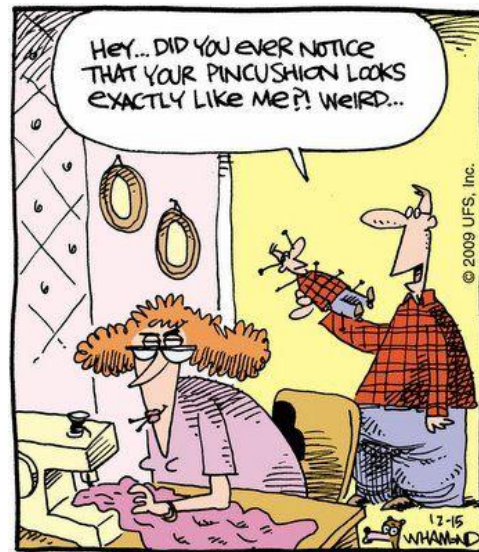

MARCH 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

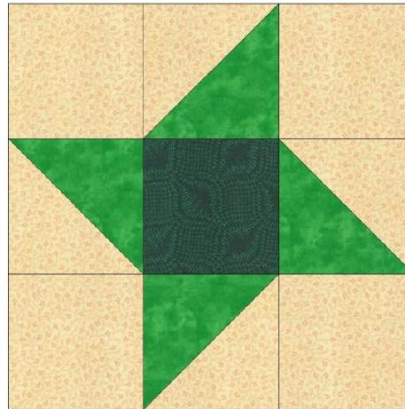
Fabric: Beige, Dark Green, & Light Green

Cutting:

Beige: Cut four 4-1/2" X 4-1/2" squares
Cut two 5" squares, cut in half diagonally
To make four triangles

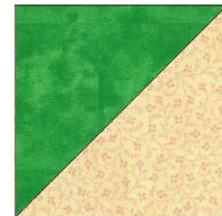
Light Green: Cut two 5" squares, cut in half
Diagonally to make four triangles

Dark Green: Cut one 4-1/2" square



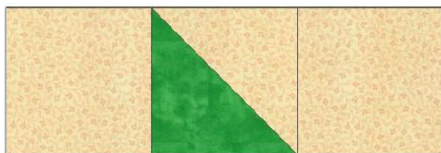
Sewing:

Pair each beige triangle with a light green triangle and sew together on the longest side to make a half square triangle. Trim to a 4-1/2" square. Makes four sets.



Arrange your nine patch as shown in the block above.

Sew two rows like this:



Sew one row like this:



Press all seams to the solid squares. Sew the 3 rows together in the order shown above.

Don't forget to make your own block to keep for your sampler quilt! 😊

February 2, 2016 Quilt Board Meeting

Location: Prince Frederick Library

Members in Attendance: Pat Blackford, Allison Korb (& Harvey Korb)

Board Meeting commenced at 7:00 pm.

Discussions:

1) 2015 Budget

- We spent \$778.45 more than what we brought in
- We will still honor any speaker & workshop commitments
- We will attempt to look at ways to save until income improves

2) Remaining amount due from Rhonda.

- Board recommends spending up to \$500 on court costs to file a civil suit in small claims court to obtain reimbursement.
- We will request that our fees be reimbursed as well.
- Our suggestion is that she has \$80 per paycheck automatically deducted for payment. This will fulfill her payments over a two-year period without causing any drastic financial hardship to her.
- We will present this to the membership for a yay or nay vote on February 10.

3) 2016 Elections

- We need a nominating committee for 2016 elections
- Pat & Allison will hold their positions if elected
- Need to hear from Julie and Andrea
- Need to appoint one person and take two volunteers
- Pat will call Claudia Thornburg to see if she will be the appointed person

4) Expense Reimbursement

- Discussed reimbursement to Allison for \$17 (with receipt) for plastic storage bins for all of the old treasurer's documents. The current cardboard boxes aren't holding up.
- Pat approved reimbursement.
- We will also look into how many years it is necessary for a 501c3 organization to keep documentation and trim down the binders from there. Obviously, keeping any years pertaining to the Rhonda issue.

5) Harvey requested fruit gummy snacks and gave a presentation on shark dorsal fins compared to fish fins.

Business Meeting

President Pat Blackford opened the business meeting at 7:06 pm.

Pat Blackford informed the guild on the issue with Rhonda's case. Whereas there was not 2/3 of the guild present, and referring to the bylaws, it was interpreted that the Guild's Board could make the decision and inform the Guild.

Sunshine Committee - A Thank You card was going to be sent to Spice Island Wicker for their donation to the Guild.
