GETTIN' ZIGGY WITH IT BLOCK

12" FINISHED BLOCK

FABRICS: White, Purple, Blue

Cutting:

White Fabric: Four 4-1/4" squares, Four 3-1/2" squares

Blue Fabric: Two 4-1/4" squares, Two 3-1/2" squares

Purple Fabric: Two 4-1/4" squares, Two 3-1/2" squares

Piecing:

Layer the larger four white squares with the larger two each of the blue and purple. Mark a diagonal on each from one corner to the opposite corner. Now sew a 1/4" seam on either side of this line. Cut the line to make TWO half square triangles. Use a ruler to trim the half square triangles to 3-1/2" inch squares.



Assemble your 4 rows and sew together as shown above.

Your block should measure 12-1/2" square when done.

Makes a pretty neat quilt when you alternate the blocks!
