

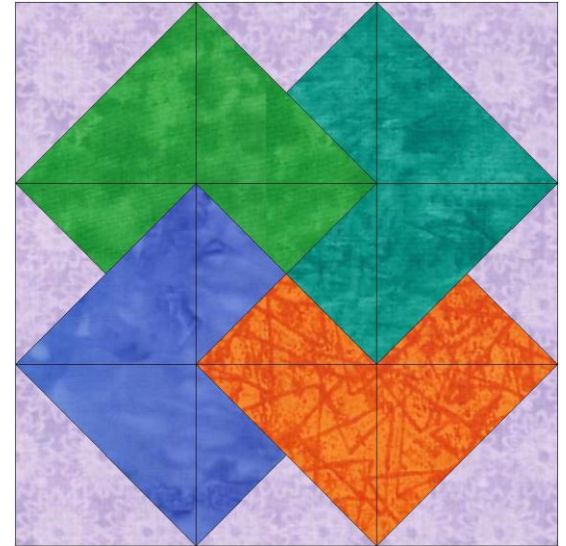
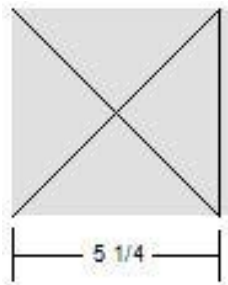
NOVEMBER 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Fabric: Batik Madness!!! – Pick 5 batiks.....
One for background, 4 for squares

Cutting:

Background – Cut TWO squares $4\text{-}\frac{7}{8}\text{''}$ X $4\text{-}\frac{7}{8}\text{''}$
Cut those in half diagonally to make FOUR triangles

Cut ONE $5\text{-}\frac{1}{4}\text{''}$ X $5\text{-}\frac{1}{4}\text{''}$ square. Cut in half diagonally TWICE to get FOUR triangles



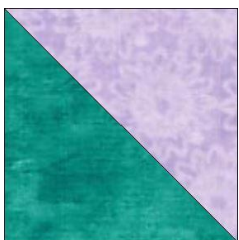
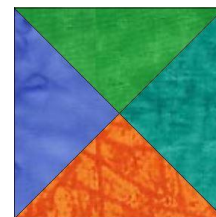
Colors: Cut ONE $4\text{-}\frac{7}{8}\text{''}$ X $4\text{-}\frac{7}{8}\text{''}$ square from each of the FOUR colors. Cut those squares in half diagonally to make two triangles of each color.

Cut ONE $5\text{-}\frac{1}{4}\text{''}$ X $5\text{-}\frac{1}{4}\text{''}$ square from each color. Cut those in half diagonally twice (as shown above) to make four triangles. Save two of the triangles, discard two.

Very carefully lay out your block on a design board or wall as shown above.

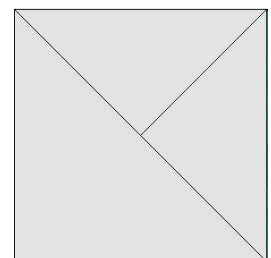
Sewing:

Sew your four center pieces together using the smaller triangles...



Then Sew one of each Large colored triangle to one of each background fabric triangle. Make Four sets.....

Next make FOUR sets alternating your fabrics (follow your layout) of a small background fabric, color 1 (large) and color 2 (small) triangles.



Treat as a nine patch and assemble carefully to get the proper layout.

Don't forget to make your own block in your own colors to keep for your sampler quilt! ☺
