

CALVERT COUNTY QUILT GUILD OCTOBER 2015 BOM WONKY STARS 12" FINISHED BLOCK

Fabric: 8 bright (tropical) fabrics, 1 bright white (solid if possible)

Cutting:

All Fabrics: Cut One 4-1/2" square (1 of each color and the white)

White Fabric: Cut 8 scrap pieces to sew over corners for wonky star points

Sewing:

Pick 4 of the colored squares to add points to. Sew a section (randomly) over 2 of the corners of the colored square. Press it back and trim excess back to the 4-1/2" square. Trim excess from the back. Your triangles should not be even.







Assemble all finished 4-1/2" squares like the nine patch shown above.

Reference Missouri Star Quilt Company "wonky star" on you tube for additional help making wonky star points. Use measurements our measurements though. Single block should measure 12-1/2" when finished.
