

OCTOBER 2016 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Fabric: Black (or Halloween Print)
Two purples
Two oranges

Cutting:

Black Print: Two 4-3/4" squares
Four 3-7/8" Squares
Cut each of the 3-7/8" squares in half diagonally to make two triangles. You should get 8 black triangles total.

Orange Prints: One 4-3/4" square of each

Purple prints: Two 3-7/8" squares of each, cut those in half diagonally to make FOUR triangles



Sewing:

Pair up each of the orange squares with FOUR black triangles. Mark the center of each side of the square and the center point of the longest side of the triangles. Match up and sew opposite sides first, then the second set. Make 2.

Do the same to the black squares. Match up with two sets of purple triangles.

Sew each orange square to a black square. Press to the orange squares. Flip and sew together to complete the block.

Your block should measure 12.5" X 12.5" when done.

You can always use a scant 1/4" and trim the sets to 6.5" square prior to sewing them together.



Don't forget to make your own block in your own colors to keep for your sampler quilt! ☺
