**Paths & Stiles**

Unfinished Block Size – 9 1/2"

Oldie but Goodie from the archives

**Pattern from: Quilting @ About.com**  
**Fabrics: Beige and a Floral**

**Cutting:**

- Beige: Four 4" squares  
 Two 1-1/2" X 15" strips  
 Floral: Four 4" squares  
 One 1-1/2" X 15" strip  
 One 3-1/2" Square

**Piecing:**

Sew your two beige 1-1/2" strips to each side of the floral 1-1/2" strip. Press to the floral fabric and then cut into 3-1/2" squares.



Next layer each beige 4" square on top of a floral 4" square. Sew a diagonal seam across each set. Press to the floral side. Trim away any excess remaining beyond a 1/4". Trim each half square triangle to 3-1/2" square.



Assemble the pieces into rows, then sew the rows together.

Your unfinished block should measure 9-1/2" square.
